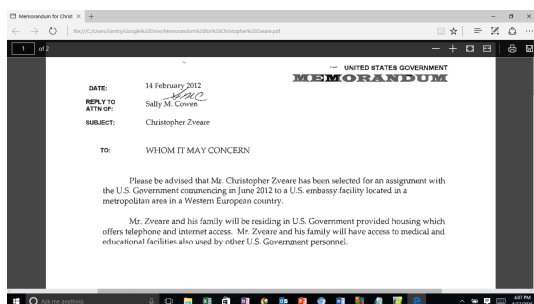


Loudoun County - Christopher Zveare submitted a false document
